Chapter 13

The Bankruptcy Court in the Danville/Urbana Division, Central District of Illinois, currently requires Debtors' counsel to submit a detailed fee itemization in any Chapter 13 case where compensation sought is in excess of \$2,000. Effective December 8, 2005, this Court will require a detailed fee itemization where the fee sought is in excess of \$2,500. The Court expects Debtors' attorneys to comply with the detailed fee order which was effective January 1, 2005, which lists the duties required of Debtors' attorneys in Chapter 13 cases.

Chapter 7

Effective December 8, 2005, for Chapter 7 cases filed on and after that date, the review threshold for fees paid or payable to the debtor's attorney shall be \$2,000. The Court will require an itemized fee application where the fees disclosed exceed this amount.

This Standing Order shall be applicable to cases filed on and after December 8, 2005.
