FOR DEBTORS' COUNSEL
IN CHAPTER 13 AND CHAPTER 7 PROCEEDINGS


Chapter 13

The Bankruptcy Court in the Danville/Urbana Division, Central District of Illinois, currently requires Debtors' counsel to submit a detailed fee itemization in any Chapter 13 case where compensation sought is in excess of \$1,500. Effective January 1, 2003, this Court will now require a detailed fee itemization where the fee sought is in excess of \$1,700. The Court expects Debtors' attorneys to comply with the Supplemental Order Regarding Attorney Fees for Debtor's Counsel in Chapter 13 Cases dated August 15, 2001, which lists the duties required of Debtors' attorneys in Chapter 13 cases.

Chapter 7

The Bankruptcy Court in the Danville/Urbana Division, Central District of Illinois, has no specific dollar review level, but reviews Chapter 7 attorney fees for reasonableness.
