ORDER REGARDING ATTORNEY FEES  
FOR DEBTORS' COUNSEL  
IN CHAPTER 13 AND CHAPTER 7 PROCEEDINGS

Chapter 13


The Bankruptcy Court in the Danville/Urbana Division, Central District of Illinois, currently requires Debtors' counsel to submit a detailed fee itemization in any Chapter 13 case where compensation sought is in excess of \$2,500. Effective January 1, 2008, this Court will require a detailed fee itemization where the fee sought is in excess of \$3,000. The Court expects Debtors' attorneys to comply with the detailed fee order effective January 1, 2008, which lists the duties required of Debtors' attorneys in Chapter 13 cases.

Chapter 7

Effective January 1, 2008, for Chapter 7 cases filed on and after that date, the review threshold for fees paid or payable to the debtor's attorney shall be \$2,500. The Court will require an itemized fee application where the fees disclosed exceed this amount.

This Standing Order shall be applicable to cases filed on and after January 1, 2008.
