UPDATES TO THE MISCELLANEOUS FEE SCHEDULE

AMENDED BANKRUPTCY RULES

AMENDED BANKRUPTCY FORMS

EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2013

At its September 2013 session, the Judicial Conference approved several changes to the federal court miscellaneous fee schedules, effective December 1, 2013, as discussed below:

- (a) A \$64 retrieval fee for the retrieval of one box of records from a Federal Records Center, National Archives, or other storage location. For retrievals involving multiple boxes, there is a \$39 fee for the retrieval of each additional box.
- (b) Change in terminology to encompass any payment returned or denied for insufficient funds, \$53.
- (c) A filing fee of \$176 for motions to sell property of the estate free and clear of liens under 11 U.S.C. §363(f).

The Supreme Court of the United States has adopted amendments to the following rules:

Bankruptcy Rules 1007(b)(7), 4004(c)(1), 5009(b), 9006(d), 9013, and 9014. These rules will take effect on December 1, 2013 and can be accessed at:

The following amendments to the Official Bankruptcy Forms will take effect on December 1, 2013: 3A, 3B, 6I, 6J, 6, 23, and 27. Additionally, three existing Directors Procedural forms for subpoenas – 254 (Subpoena for Rule 2004 Examination), 255 (Subpoena in an Adversary Proceeding), and 256 (Subpoena in a case Under the Bankruptcy Code) – will be withdrawn on December 1, 2013, and replaced with four updated versions (Forms 254, 255, 256, and 257) that incorporate pending changes to Civil Rule 45, which is made applicable in bankruptcy cases by Bankruptcy Rule 9016.
